




Global temperature change (1850–2016)





- 1980 Installation
- Out of pocket cost: \$2,400 after \$1,600 Federal tax rebate
- 6 month supply of hot water every year (120 gallon tank)
- Low maintenance, zero dependence on fossil fuels

Goal: \$0 electricity bills



15kW PV solar system: 48 panels

- \$50K total cost
- \$6K CT State rebate
- \$14K Federal rebate
- \$9K additional for ground (vs. roof) installation
- \$10/month utility storage charge

Benefits

- 3.2 MWh generated to date; 15.5MWh expected yearly output
- 25 year warranted life expectancy
- 4,500 lbs. CO₂ avoided
- Equivalent to planting 110 trees
